With built in features for families you're sure to spend an afternoon full of peanuts and cracker jacks! Our favorite family friendly stadiums include:

- 1. Sloan Park-Chicago Cubs (Mesa): Reminiscent of Wrigley Field you can experience Chicago-style hot dogs without hopping on a plane! Before the game hit up Riverview Park with a unique playground and fishing pond for all ages. For some added fun have a picnic before the game!
- 2. Salt River Fields at Talking Stick-Arizona Diamondbacks & Colorado Rockies (Scottsdale): Cold Stone Kids Fun Field-opens one hour and ten minutes before the first pitch. Kids can take Wiffle Ball batting practice and run the bases! Plus purchase your favorite Cold Stone Creamery creations!
- 3. Camelback Ranch Los Angeles Dodgers & Chicago White Sox (Glendale): The beautiful landscaping complete with a fish stocked lake, 3,000 bermed grass seats and famous Dodger Dogs!
- 4. **Scottsdale Stadium-San Francisco Giants** (Scottsdale): By far one of the most popular stadiums in the league, it's also a great date spot! Leave the kiddos at home and catch happy hour at a sun-filled patio in Old Town then take one of the numerous trollies to the stadium!
- 5. Peoria Sports Complex-San Diego Padres & Seattle Mariners (Peoria): With a special kids club for those 14 and under, the kiddos will love a trip to Peoria Sports Complex! Tips to make your day more pleasurable!

- 1. Buy tickets in advance: some stadiums/teams sell out and some don't!
- 2. Consider lawn seats. If the game isn't busy it will allow for more room to "expend some energy"
- 3. Bring lots of sunscreen!
- 4. Watch the weather! It's already in the mid-80's and you'll get hot! Bring plenty of unopened bottles of water (check stadium website for rules).
- 5. Know when to call it quits for the day. Since most games are a low-cost investment don't feel like you have to stick it out for the entire game. Sometimes an couple of hours is the perfect amount of time!




